MISSION STATEMENT-STANDING RULES

The "Stones" Car Club is an organization formed by individuals with an interest in the restoration, preservation and enjoyment of all classes of cars such as Antiques, Classics, Special Interest, and Modified vehicles.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this group is to attend car shows together, share information about upcoming car show events, sponsor "Show & Shine" vehicle event(s) locally, and share in the fun and fellowship of our community. The proceeds gathered through these events will be donated to the charity of the club's choosing. This club will not organize or host a performance driving event.

MEMBERSHIP

All car owners with vehicles manufactured or replicas are eligible to join this club. Application for membership will be accepted after the prospective member has attended two meetings. The membership will vote on acceptance after the 2nd meeting. Applicants will be notified of the results by mail prior to the next regular meeting. Candidate is a bona fide member after they have paid their dues. Stones Car Club operates on a fiscal year with \$25 dues per applicant household.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

Meetings will be held on the 3rd Thursday of each month. Members will receive e-mail notification or written notice of each meeting date, time and place as a reminder.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors will be composed of seven members: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Activities Director, Membership Director and Member-at -Large.

TERMS OF SERVICE

The members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by the general membership and shall serve a two year term with three of the terms of office expiring in even numbered years and four expiring in odd numbered years. The members so elected shall meet and determine among themselves the specific position each will occupy. Positions on the Board will be determined annually by the Board. (The three members of the Board of Directors receiving the highest number of votes in the initial election shall serve for two years; the four members receiving the fewest votes shall serve for one year. For subsequent years, the terms of office shall be for two years for each board member.

DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

PRESIDENT: Will preside over meetings of the Board and General Membership. Has the right to sit in on any committee meeting, call any special meeting, and be Chairman of the Car Show or appoint a Chairman.

VICE-PRESIDENT: Shall serve as acting President in the President's absence and will serve as the Sergeant of Arms, being responsible for maintaining order at club meetings and functions.

SECRETARY: Will take and maintain a record of all regular meetings and Board of Director meetings. All minutes will be stored in a binder given to the Historian annually for the permanent records of the Club.

TREASURER: To maintain an orderly set of books according to the generally accepted rules of accounting and to report to the Board and membership all account activity and balances monthly.

ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR: To organize and publish sanctioned activities and events of all members, either by newsletter, e-mail, direct mail or telephone.

MEMBERSHIP DIRECTOR: To maintain a membership packet for new applicants and keep all members informed of new members, introducing the new members when possible.

MEMBER AT LARGE: Attend Board and regular meetings. Duties as assigned by the President. Maintain Roberts Rules of Order.

COMMITTEES

Committee Chairpersons can be appointed annually by the Board of Directors at their first organizational meeting. Committees will include, but not be limited to the following:

1. Historian – To maintain the Club's historical documents in an organized fashion.
2. Newsletter Editor – to publish and distribute the monthly newsletter for the enjoyment of Club members and similar Clubs.
3. Web Master – to set up and oversee a website of all pertinent information regarding the Club.

RULES OF CONDUCT

Public displays of negativity and/or disrespect towards any Club member(s) and/or to their property at any Club function are not acceptable. Illegal drugs, excessive drinking and/or reckless driving including illegal racing are not acceptable at any Club function. Members must ensure that any invited guest(s) at Club functions conduct themselves in the same orderly manner required of Club members.
